


- (a) The above vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. Director, JIPMER reserves the right to vary the above vacancies as per requirements of the Institute or otherwise.
- (b) For posts listed at Sr. No. 1b, 4, 12a, 12b, 12c, 12d, 13b, 30b: The selected candidates may be required to share the other clinical/teaching work in the department beyond the area indicated in the post name.
- (c) Horizontal Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD): 5 backlog vacancies. The functional requirements and Benchmark Disability (BD) for each Department are mentioned in Annexure 1. The functional requirements and BD for (i) Geriatric Medicine will be the same as that for Medicine (ii) Laboratory Services will be same as that for Pathology and (iii) JISPH and Preventive Oncology will be the same as that for Preventive and Social Medicine.
- (d) Initially only EWS applicants will be considered for the vacancies earmarked for EWS category. *However, in case any EWS vacancy remains unfilled due to non-availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS or otherwise, such vacancies may be filled by UR category*. Hence eligible applicants from other categories are allowed to provisionally apply against the posts earmarked for EWS subject to the conditions that: (i) their candidature will be considered only if a suitable candidate from EWS category is not available or the vacancy is otherwise not filled and (ii) their candidature will be as UR candidates and hence there shall be no relaxations otherwise permitted under specific categories, i.e. SC, ST or OBC.

Further, if a candidate wishes to apply for more than one post i.e., Professor and Assistant Professor or, wishes to apply for more than one discipline/specialty, he/she must apply separately.
- 7. The details for applying Online are as follows:

 - Applicants should read these instructions carefully before filling the online application form.
- 8. The applicant must upload a coloured photograph and signature as per the following details:

a) Photograph : 50 Kb - 200 Kb (Only JPEG and JPG formats)

b) Signature : 50 Kb - 200 Kb (Only JPEG and JPG formats)

- 9. All the posts carry usual allowances as admissible to JIPMER employees.
- 10. All applicants from other categories are *allowed to provisionally apply against the posts earmarked for EWS* as mentioned in Note (d) of page 2.
- 11. The **crucial date** for determination of upper age limit, qualification and experience will be **the last date of online submission of application** (i.e. 18/09/2025). The period of experience will be counted only after obtaining the prescribed education qualification for the respective post.
- 12. In case of applicants already employed in Central/State Govt./Autonomous Institutions/Statutory organization/PSU's under Central/State Govt. on regular basis, he/she should route his/her application(s) through proper channel. While forwarding the application(s) through proper channel, a certificate to the effect that Central Govt./State Govt./Union Territory or the present Department/Organizations has "No Objection" for the Officer to apply for JIPMER, Puducherry/Karaikal must be submitted along with the application so that, in case of selection, the faculty concerned will be relieved from the present Department/Organization to join JIPMER, Puducherry/Karaikal
- 13. In case of age relaxation for government servants, age relaxation will be admissible only to those employees working under Central Government not under Autonomous Body/State Government/PSU and working in posts which are in the same line or allied cadres and here a relationship could be established that the service already rendered in a particular post will be useful for the efficient discharge of duties of the post(s) to which has been advertised. Decision in the regard will rest with the competent authority, JIPMER.
- 14. No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying for unreserved vacancies.
- 15. The **persons belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWSs/PwBD must submit the certificate** in the requisite proforma duly issued by the authority concerned (*if applicable*).
 - OBC (non-creamy layer) Certificate issued by the competent authority during the current financial year i.e., between 1.4.2025 and 31.3.2026 will be considered as VALID CERTIFICATE
 - Income and Assets certificate to be produced by Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) should be valid for the year 2025-26.

18. **DEFINITION OF CATEGORIES**

- (i) Unreserved (UR): Unreserved stands for all applicants including OBC/SC/ST/EWSs. (Only such SC/ST/OBC/EWSs candidates who are selected on the same standard as applied to general candidates shall be treated as own merit candidates. If any SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidate is selected by getting any relaxation in age, etc., he/she shall be counted against reserved vacancies. Such a candidate cannot be considered for appointment against an unreserved vacancy).
- (ii) Other Backward Classes (OBC): Applicants are required to ensure that he/she does not belong to the persons/sections (Creamy Layer) mentioned in Column 3 of the Schedule to the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/93 which is modified vide OM No. 36033/3/2004 Estt. (Res.) dated 09/03/2004 or the latest notification of the Government of India (i.e. Central list) in support of his/her claim. - (iii) Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe (SC/ST): Applicants are required to produce the necessary certificate as prescribed in M.H.A., O.M., No. 42/21/49-N.G.S. dated the 28.1.1952, as revised in Dept. of Per-& A.R. letter No. 36012/6/76-Est. (S.CT), dated the 29.10.1977, to be produced by candidate belonging to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe in support of his/her claim.
- (iv) Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD): The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability. The degree of the candidates' disability will be assessed by the JIPMER medical board, whose decision will be final in this regard.
- (v) Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs): Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh Only) are to be identified as EWS for benefit of reservation. Income shall include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:

- a) 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- b) Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- c) Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- d) Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. (As per the Office Memorandum F.No.36039/1/2019 dt 31st January 2019 by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances& Pension & F.No. A11013/01/2019 dt. 28th February 2019 by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India).

19. MODE OF SELECTION: Personal interview / Online by video conferencing

In case a huge number of applications are received for any discipline, then either a written exam may be conducted for shortlisting the candidates (or) the Standing Selection Committee may shortlist candidates for the interview. The decision of the competent authority at JIPMER will be final.

- 20. **Interviews** to the advertised posts will be held in a **phased manner**. The decision of the competent authority, JIPMER in this regard will be final and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- 21. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the Personal interview.
- 22. The selected candidates for JIPMER, Karaikal will be posted to work at JIPMER Karaikal campus and they will not have any right to seek their transfer to JIPMER Puducherry campus.
- 23. Canvassing of any kind in favour of any candidate will lead to disqualification.
- 24. The applicant should not have been convicted by any court of law.
- 25. The disputes, if any with regard to eligibility/selection process/appointment etc., will be subject to Jurisdiction of Puducherry/ Chennai.
